

**CITY OF GASSVILLE, ARKANSAS
MINUTES FOR THE REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
SEPTEMBER 22, 2015**

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Gassville, Arkansas was held on Tuesday, September 22, 2015 at the Gassville Community Center. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM by Mayor Jeff Braim, Presiding Officer. The Mayor led those in attendance in saying the pledge of allegiance to the flag and in offering a word of prayer.

Upon the calling of the roll, those in attendance were Alderman Kayla Holland, Alderman Tim McFarland, Alderman Anita Seaman, Alderman Naomi Lassen, Alderman Rick Peglar, Alderman Ralph Bird, Mayor Jeff Braim, and Recorder-Treasurer Jeff Lewis. Department Heads in attendance were Fire Chief Bill Johnson and Water and Street Superintendent Tony Flippin.

The minutes from the August 18, 2015 council meeting were submitted for approval. Alderman Bird moved to approve the minutes, with a second from Alderman Lassen. There were no additions or corrections asked for. Mayor Braim then called for a vote to approve the minutes. Alderman Holland, Alderman McFarland, Alderman Seaman, Alderman Lassen, Alderman Peglar, and Alderman Bird voted for the motion. There were no nays, and the Mayor declared the motion carried.

The financial statement for the month of August, 2015 was submitted for approval. Alderman Lassen moved to approve the financial statement as submitted. This motion was seconded by Alderman Bird. The Mayor informed council that corrections needed to be made from the figures shown to General Fund Expense Line Items 1517 – Police Misc. and 1524 – Police Vehicle. He provided the corrected figures and indicated that they involved making additional payments on the newest police vehicle above what was shown. The Mayor will provide each Alderman with a new budget print-out indicating the adjusted numbers to those line items and adjusted General Fund totals. The Mayor called for the vote to approve the financial statement with the adjustments he mentioned. Alderman Holland, Alderman McFarland, Alderman Seaman, Alderman Lassen, Alderman Peglar, and Alderman Bird voted for the motion. There were no nays, and the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Police Chief Mayfield was absent from the meeting, and the Mayor gave the police department report for the month on August on his behalf. It was accepted into the record without objection.

Fire Chief Johnson gave the fire department report for the month of August. In addition to the report, Chief Johnson informed council that the Gassville Volunteer Fire Department will be benefiting from Assistance to Firefighters (AFG) grant funds applied
